From Worcester: 395 south to route 6 east, at 2nd flashing light go right onto Cucumber Hill Rd., follow for 8 miles to stop sign, cross route 14, right onto Hall Rd., bear left at fork onto Waterman Hill Rd. (farm on right)

From Tiverton/Newport: Rt 138 west to Rt 4 north to Rt 102 north to Waterman Hill Rd. (left). (farm on left)

From Mystic: 95 north to exit 5, north on Rt 102, follow for approx. 10 miles, left onto Waterman Rd., farm on left.

Rules and Regulations

1. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and regulations of the current USEF, NEHC, SEHA, MHJ, AHA and RIHA Rule Books (where applicable) and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
2. To be eligible for stake and/or championship classes, entrants must have shown in an over fences class in the Hunter Division and shown in at least one other class in the same division for other than the Hunter Division. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of entry fee and any prize awarded.
3. Ocean State Hunt Club and their officials and employees will not be held responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to an exhibitor, spectator, guest, rider, groom, attendant, or any other employee, animal or equipment.
4. Prize money will be awarded at the secretary's stand when all entries are paid in full.
5. No refunds will be made without a veterinary certificate or a physician's certificate in the case of the rider. Credit will be applied for a future show.
6. Any returned checks will be charged a \$25 fee.
7. Entries close the Friday before the show. Post entries will be charged a fee of \$15 for the day. No calls will be accepted after 8:00PM.
8. All dogs must be leashed.
9. No alcoholic beverages allowed on premises.
10. Hunter classes may go "back to back" at the discretion of the management.
11. All entries in Medal, Amateur Owner, Junior and Pony Hunter classes must present membership and/or measurement cards to the Show Secretary prior to the class.
12. Management reserves the right to decline any entry, and to cancel, combine or divide classes when deemed necessary to facilitate the smooth running of the show.
13. All juniors in Hunter and Hunter Seat Equitation sections cannot ride anywhere on the show grounds without wearing protective headgear passing testing standards. Harnesses must be secured and if said headgear has a brim, it must be flexible or semi-flexible. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until his headgear is properly in place. Adults are encouraged to comply with this rule, however, it is not mandatory.
14. Schooling will be permitted in authorized areas only. Anyone found violating this rule shall forfeit all entry fees and not be allowed to show.
15. Hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. Equitation classes will be judged on on seat, hands, and guidance and control of the horse.
16. Exhibitors must be in proper attire for all classes.
17. During judging, no one other than the rider(s) is allowed in the ring except on official business.
18. All exhibitors in the amateur section of this show must present their Amateur Certification cards before numbers are issued.
19. Measurement cards: All exhibitors in the Junior/Pony/Children's Hunter Sections must present their measurement cards at the Show Office before numbers may be picked up.
20. Entry Fees: \$15 unless specified otherwise. Warm Ups Only: \$50.

HUNTER SEAT EQUITATION DIVISION

Classes 3, 4, 7-14: NEHC - B, RIHA - B

Classes 1, 2: RIHA - B, SEHA - B

Entry Fee Classes 1&2: \$15.00; 3 & 5-14: \$15.00; 4: \$25.00

1. LEADLINE - Open to riders 6 years of age and under. To be shown collectively at the walk and individually at the trot. To be judged with emphasis on equitation; suitability and manners of mount to be considered. Leader must be on foot and must be over 14 years of age. May not compete in any other under saddle class at this show.
2. LEADLINE SUITABILITY - Same specifications as class 1.
3. WALK TROT EQUITATION - Open to riders 10 years of age and under. To be shown at a walk and trot or jog ONLY. Entries may not compete in any class requiring canter.
4. WALK TROT EQUITATION SEHA CHAMPIONSHIP - Same specifications as class 3
5. LIMIT EQUITATION FLAT - "Open to riders who have not won six blue ribbons in equitation at recognized shows. Walk, trot, canter. Tests 1 - 7."
6. LIMIT EQUITATION FENCES - "Open to riders who have not won six blue ribbons over fences in equitation at recognized shows. Fences not to exceed 2'9\"". Tests 1 - 7."
7. OPEN EQUITATION 11 AND UNDER FLAT - "For Juniors who have not reached their 12th birthday. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Tests 1 - 7."
8. OPEN EQUITATION 11 AND UNDER FENCES - "For Juniors who have not reached their 12th birthday. Fences not to exceed 2'6\"". Tests 1 - 7."
9. OPEN EQUITATION 12-14 FLAT - "For Juniors between the ages of 12-14. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Tests 1 - 8."
10. OPEN EQUITATION 12-14 FENCES - "For Juniors between the ages of 12-14. Fences not to exceed 2'6\"". Tests 1 - 8."
11. OPEN EQUITATION 15-17 FLAT - "For Juniors between the ages of 15 - 17. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Tests 1 - 19."
12. OPEN EQUITATION 15-17 FENCES - "For Juniors between the ages of 15 - 17. Jumps not to exceed 3'6\"". Tests 1 - 19."
13. ADULT AMATUER HUNT SEAT EQ FLAT - "To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. For riders who have reached their 18th birthday, and over. Tests 1 - 7."
14. ADULT AMATUER HUNT SEAT EQ FENCES - "For riders 18 years and over. Eight fences not to exceed 3'0\"". Tests 1 - 7."

CHILDREN'S EQUITATION NEHC B/RIHA B

Entry Fee: \$15.00 per class.

Open to exhibitors who are eligible for Children's Hunter. Riders may not enter into any other class at the same horse show where fences exceed 3'0". Fences for horses and large ponies: 2'6"; small/medium ponies 2'0".

Qualifying class for MHJ Children's Equitation

18. RIHA HUNT SEAT MINI MEDAL Entry Fee: \$25.00 Open to junior members of the Rhode Island Horsemen's Association and to riders 15-17 years of age who are eligible for limit equitation over fences as of December 1 in current show year and have not competed in classes in which the entry may be required to jump higher is required to jump higher than three feet. All contestants are to compete over a course not exceeding eight fences and not less than six fences, excluding combination fences, at a height not to exceed 2'6" with at least one change of direction. One or more individual tests may be requested, at the judges discretion. (USEF Current tests 1-8). To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course."

19. RIHA HUNT SEAT MEDAL Entry Fee: \$25.00 "Open to Junior members of the Rhode Island Horsemen's Association who have not reached their eighteenth birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not exceeding 3' with at least one change of direction. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF Tests 1 - 19). To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course."

20. RIHA AMATEUR ADULT HUNT SEAT MEDAL Entry Fee: \$25.00 Open to adult amateur members of the Rhode Island's Horseman's Association. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not exceeding 3' with at least one change of direction. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF Tests 1 - 19). To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course.

21. NEHJ JUNIOR TALENT MEDAL Entry Fee: \$25.00 Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of Dec. 1, 2008. Riders shall perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3'. Time allowed will be figured at 360 yards per minute and calculated manually or electronically. At the judges discretion riders may be required to compete in a flat phase. To fill a class, at least two comeditors must complete the course. Ten points are required to qualify for the finals. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class until Aug. 1, 2009. After Aug. 1, 2009 only those riders not qualified may compete in the class. Riders may cross enter into the MHJ Junior Medal.

22. NEHJ ADULT TALENT MEDAL Entry Fee: \$25.00 Open to horses or ponies to be ridden by an Amateur Adult. Riders shall perform over at least eight fences not exceeding 3'. At the judges discretion riders may be required to compete in a flat phase. To fill a class, at least two comeditors must complete the course. Ten points are required to qualify for the finals. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class until Aug. 1, 2009. After Aug. 1, 2009 only those riders not qualified may compete in the class. Riders may cross enter into the MHJ Adult Medal.

23. M&S PONY MEDAL 2' small/medium. 2'6" large. Three to qualify

24. NEHC HUNT SEAL MEDAL Entry Fee: \$25.00 "Open to Junior members of the New England Horsemen's Council who have not reached their eighteenth birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not exceeding 3'3\"". One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the Judge's discretion. (USEF Tests 1 - 19). To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course. One win required to qualify for the Finals. All contestants must wear proper attire. Once a contestant has qualified, they are no longer eligible for the qualifying classes. Violation will forfeit eligibility for the finals for that year."

25. NEHC AMATEUR ADULT HUNT SEAT MEDAL Entry Fee: \$25.00 "Open to adult amateur members of NEHC. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3'. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the Judge's discretion. (USEF Current Tests 1 - 19). To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course. All contestants must wear proper attire. Once a contestant has qualified they are no longer eligible for the preliminary classes. Violation will forfeit eligibility for the finals for that year."

26. THIS NATIONAL CHILDREN'S MEDAL Entry Fee: \$25.00 (Formerly known as SMC Children's Medal) To be Shown over a minimum of eight fences 2'9" to 3' in height, spread not to exceed fence height. The course may be either a hunter or jumper type course and must include at least two changes of direction and a combination. Water obstacles (i.e. water jump, liverpool) are not permitted. The top four riders or 20% of the first round competitors, whichever is greater, are required to perform at least two individual tests from AHSA tests 1 - 19. An Open Numerical Scoring System must be used in the first round, with each rider's score announced at the completion of their round. At least six ribbons shall be awarded in each qualifying class.

27. **M+S CHILDRENS MEDAL** Entry Fee: \$30.00
Open to Junior Riders who are not competing at the same show in any hunter of equitation class with fences exceeding 3'3". To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences the required height including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. To fill the class, three riders must complete the course. The rider must be a member for points to qualify for the finals. If entries warrant and League approves, class may be divided by horses and ponies. (Fence height at the Finals: Horses 3', Ponies 2' Small/Medium, 2'6" for Large.
28. **SEHA MINI-MEDAL** Entry Fee: \$25.00
Open to SEHA members who have not reached their 15th birthday as of Dec. 1st of the current year and have not competed in any horsemanship class in which the rider is required to jump higher than 3'. All contestants are to compete over a course not to exceed 8 fences and not less than 6 fences, at a height not to exceed 2'6". No combinations. One or more individual tests may be requested at the Judge's discretion. (USEF Tests 1 - 5). Contestants are not allowed to cross enter into the National Children's Medal, WIHS, MHC, NEHC, and RIHA Medal, USEF Medal, USET, or the ASPCA Horsemanship class at any show during the year. To fill a class at least four competitors must complete the course. Ten points to qualify for the Finals. (10, 6, 4, 2, 1, 1/2). Once qualified you may still enter the class. If you have won the Mini Medal Finals, you are no longer eligible for this class.
29. **SEHA JUNIOR MEDAL CLASS** Entry Fee: \$25.00
Open to Junior members who have not reached their 18th birthday as of Dec 1st of the current year. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not to exceed 3'3" in height. One or more tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the Judge's discretion. (USAE Tests 1 - 19). To fill, at least 4 competitors must complete the course. Ten points required to qualify for the Finals. Once qualified, you may still enter the class. If you won the Junior Medal at the Finals, you are no longer eligible for this class.
30. **SEHA ADULT MEDAL** Entry Fee: \$25.00
Open to Amateur Adult riders. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 2'9" - 3' including a combination with at least two changes of direction after the first fence. To fill, at least 2 competitors must complete the course. Ten points to qualify. Once qualified you may still enter the class until Aug. 1, 2009. After Aug. 1, 2009 only those riders not qualified may compete in the class.
31. **MHJ MINI MEDAL** Entry Fee: \$25.00
Open to all Junior riders who have not reached their 15th birthday as of Dec. 1 of the current year. (exception Maiden and Novice riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of Dec. 1 of the current year). To perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 2'6". Riders may cross-enter into the MHJ Children's Medal Horse or Pony class at the finals. To fill, at least 2 competitors must complete the course. Ten points to qualify. Once qualified you may still enter the class until Aug. 1, 2009. After Aug. 1, 2009 only those riders not qualified may compete in the class.
32. **MHJ JUNIOR MEDAL** Entry Fee: \$25.00
Open to Junior members who have not reached their 18th birthday as of Dec. 1. All contestants are required to perform over at least 6 fences not to exceed 3' in height. Competitors may cross-enter into the NEHJ Junior Talent Medal. To fill, at least 2 competitors must complete the course. Ten points to qualify.
33. **MHJ ADULT MEDAL** Entry Fee: \$25.00
Open to all Amateur Adult competitors. Riders shall perform over at least 8 fences 2'9" to 3'0" including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Competitors may cross-enter into the NEHJ Adult Talent Medal. To fill, at least 2 competitors must complete the course. Ten points to qualify. Once qualified you may still enter the class until Aug. 1, 2009. After Aug. 1, 2009 only those riders not qualified may compete in the class. At the Finals, class will be divided 18-30 and over 30.
34. **RIHA ADULT MINI MEDAL** Entry Fee: \$25.00
Open to adult amateur riders who, as of December 1st of the current show year, have not won six blue ribbons at a **RECOGNIZED** show in Adult Equitation classes, including Adult Medal Classes, but excluding Modified Adult Classes. For amateurs who have won six blue ribbons, they are eligible for Modified Adult if, as of December 1st of the current show year, they have not shown in classes with fences 3' or higher within the past two show years. Potential qualifiers will be asked to perform over at least six fences not to exceed 2'6" with no combinations. USEF Tests 1-8 may be asked at the judge's discretion. A minimum of three exhibitors must complete the course. To qualify for the finals, an exhibitor must win one class. Once qualified a rider may continue to show in this class.
35. **BAY STATE ADULT MEDAL** Entry Fee: \$25.00
"Open to adult amateur riders. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences at 2'6"". One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion (USEF current tests 1 - 19). To fill a class, at least four riders must compete. One win or two seconds qualifies for the finals. Qualifier may ride in either NEHC or Bay State Medal Finals but not both."
36. **M+S ADULT MEDAL (3')** Entry Fee: \$30.00
"Open to Adult and Amateur Riders. To be shown over minimum of 8 fences at 3' including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. To fill the class, three riders must complete the course. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the finals."
37. **CENTRAL EQUINE JR MEDAL** Entry Fee: \$30.00
(formerly known as HBO Junior Medal)
"Open to Junior Riders. To be shown over minimum of 8 fences at 3'6" including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. To fill the class, three riders must complete the course. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the finals."
38. **ASPCA HORSEMANSHIP** Entry Fee: \$30.00
(Formerly known as NHSAA/ASPCA Horsemanship Class)
Open to Junior members of ASPCA who have not reached their 18th birthday. Must show their ASPCA number on the entry blank. To be shown over at least 8 fences not exceeding 3'6". The under saddle performance of those riders selected to show under saddle shall count 50%. To fill a class, six competitors must complete the course.
39. **USEF PONY EQUITATION** Entry Fee: \$35.00
40. **PESSOA USEF EQUESTRIAN HUNTER SEAT MEDAL** Entry Fee: \$35.00
126. **ARIAT NATIONAL ADULT MEDAL.** Entry Fee: \$30.00
To be shown over a minimum of eight fences not to exceed 3' in height, spread not to exceed fence height. The course may be either a Jumper or Hunter type course and must include at least two changes of direction and a combination. Water obstacles (i.e. water jump, liverpool) are not permitted. The top four riders, or 20% of the first round competitors, whichever is greater, are required to perform at least two individual tests from USAE Tests 1 - 19. Fences are not to exceed 2'6". Riders in this division cannot show in any other recognized classes at the same show where fences exceed 2'6".
